



Travel options during proposed strike in June 2022

How will the strikes affect travel to and within London?



On the week commencing 20th June, various strikes are planned to take place by London Underground and National Rail staff.

Trains, underground, and buses will all be affected. A number of stations across London will not be open and accessibility will be significantly reduced.

Congress Centre will remain open for events and is still accessible via the Elizabeth Line for guests and delegates.





National Rail

The planned strikes are due to take place on Tuesday 21st June, Thursday 23rd June, and Saturday 25th June, the effects will most likely be felt throughout the week.

Mainline trains are expected to run for a maximum of 12 hours on the strike days.

Not all rail companies are striking, Govia Thameslink Railway, Thameslink, Gatwick Express and Great Northern services, will all be operating as usual.





London Underground

A 24-hour strike is planned to take place on Tuesday 21st June. This will cause drastic disruptions across the tube lines.

The strike is planned to take place alongside the National Rail walkout. However London Underground is not planned to join the strikes planned on Thursday 23rd and Saturday 25th June.





London Airports

Heathrow Airport has direct access to the Elizabeth Line which will be operating as usual.

Gatwick Airport rail connections, operated by Govia Thameslink Railway, will also be operating as usual.

Luton Airport and Standsted are both expected to face severe disruptions as a result of the planned strikes.
