CONGRESS CENTRE'S GUIDE TO INCLUSIVE EVENTS

ACCESSIBLE LANGUAGE

Avoid terms that can cause offence and consider language accessibility e.g sign language, braille and video captions.



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HOLIDAYS

Check your event doesn't clash with religious or cultural holidays. If it does ensure you cater to people's needs e.g serving food during Ramadan.

FINANCES

Think about financial impact on your guests and share cost-effective travel and accommodation options.





SENSORY-FRIENDLY SPACES

Offer quiet spaces away from large crowds and low-stimulation activities for guests to retreat to.

INCLUSIVE BATHROOMS

Provide a safe and welcoming environment with gender neutral bathrooms to acknowledge diversity.





MEDICAL SUPPORT

Identify First Aid trained staff at your venue who are available to help guests, especially those with pre-existing conditions.

HYBRID ACCESSIBILITY

Offer virtual participation for guests who cannot be there in person for broader inclusion and engagement.





NAME TAGS

Let attendees customise name tags to support individual identities and comfortably share their pronouns.

INCLUSIVE CATERING

Offer vegan / vegetarian options and check your guests' dietary requirement to create a suitable menu.





MIXED EVENT CONTENT

Sense-check your content and consider gender, race, ethnicity, physical / mental ability and sexual orientation to avoid alienating members of your audience.

SPEAKER DIVERSITY

Do your speakers reflect a spectrum of backgrounds, identities, and views? Curate a varied lineup so the audience feel more understood and comfortable.





ACCESSIBLE SIGNAGE

Your audience may have hidden disabilities like visual impairments. Offer braille, verbal descriptions of visual aids and high contrast colours for text.

ANIMAL-FRIENDLY AREAS

Ensure your venue accommodates guide dogs / medical support animals. Inform staff and attendees beforehand so everyone is understanding.



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SEATING ARRANGEMENTS

Assess all areas are usable for people with different access needs to promote independence e.g spacing and ramps for wheelchairs.

EVENT FEEDBACK

Offer online and in-person channels with anonymity options to empower attendees to voice their thoughts.
